

Dear Sir or Madam,

In the context of implementing **Directive (EU) 2020/2184 (Drinking Water Directive, DWD)** and Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2024/367, binding European positive lists have been published that specify which substances may be used in materials intended to come into contact with drinking water. All listed conditions and migration limits must be complied with.

We therefore kindly request that you review all raw materials, intermediates, and materials supplied to us for their conformity with the requirements of the EU positive lists.

Filter media (e.g. activated carbon, ion exchange resins) are **not** covered by the European positive lists under Implementing Decision (EU) 2024/367. However, they must **comply** with the **hygiene requirements set out in Article 12 of Directive (EU) 2020/2184 (DWD)**.

Please confirm in writing:

1. Whether all substances used in your products are listed in EU 2024/367.
2. Whether all conditions, purity requirements, and migration limits are fulfilled.
3. Whether any non-listed substances are present that may no longer be used in the future.
4. Which transition periods, if any, apply to your materials.
5. Filter media: Compliance with the Article 12 DWD minimum hygiene requirements (health/organoleptic safety, no promotion of microbial growth).
6. When an updated Declaration of Conformity (DoC) can be made available.

We kindly request your response within 4–6 weeks so that we can complete our supply chain assessment in due time.

Please note that materials which do not comply with the relevant requirements may no longer be used after expiry of the applicable transition periods. Timely clarification is therefore necessary.
